On Thursday we held our Year 11 Parents Evening after the release of the mock results. The evening was very well attended with lots of positive conversations of how we can help our students achieve, or in many cases exceed their target grades in their GCSEs.

On Thursday 11th our final visitors for 2025 will be welcomed to the school as some of the Trust will be reviewing our progress so far this year and how we are addressing the areas for development identified by Ofsted in April. Alongside changes to the Ofsted framework, the Curriculum and Assessment Review Report has been published by the DfE with some key changes that will affect us, these changes are not immediate. Year 6 students joining the school in Sept 2026 may see some of the changes, but students currently at Ixworth should be unaffected. We will keep you informed as further information is released.




