Paper One (1h20 mins) - 52 marks - Medicine in Britain

- Topics
 - o Medieval medicine (1250-1500),
 - o Renaissance medicine (1500-1700s),
 - o Industrial era (1800s)
 - Modern era (1900s to present day including WW1 medicine)
- Themes to explore for each topic government, technology, war, people, church, institutions e.g. Royal Society how do these themes cause or prevent the development of medicine?

Paper Two – (55 mins) - 32 marks – Anglo-Saxon and Norman England

- Topics
 - What was Anglo-Saxon England like? (England before 1066) e.g. the Godwins
 - How did William gain control of England initially? e.g. three battles, castles, doomsday, Feudal system and dealing with resistance
 - How does William change England? e.g. laws, economics, religion,
 - o Williams' legacy what happens in his final years and after he dies?
- Themes to explore across this unit religion, military, economics, politics, leaders, changes, control the whole unit is about how does
 William of Normandy gain and build control of England?
